1. **Council/District Updates – Heath Johnson** – New cub scouts district round table commissioner is David Posey who did an excellent job at the Feb. round table! Twilight camp will be in Trussville in June; registration is due early (by May 29<sup>th</sup>) and we pay as a Pack so our deadline for Pack 216 will be even earlier. Can everyone give me feedback on the pack leadership document. I am specifically interested in any improvements that might be made to the overall document, better descriptions for the leadership roles in the chart (Job Description column), and any names of persons we should speak to who might be willing to take on one of the leadership roles. We need to fill the roles immediately to give each person a chance to get training and to get used to their role. We have pack trainers who could give the training if we could fill the roles right now. The roles we desperately need to fill are:

Outdoor/Activities/Camping - A critical position (we have one potential candidate)

Pack Secretary – This has been a critical job but I'm not sure it should be as critical as it has been - I'd like feedback

Pack Membership – This is a critical job in my estimation but I'd like feedback

Parent Coordinator – I'm not sure we could use one of these but I'd like to explore the idea

Assistant Cub Master – I believe we should have two of these so they could be flexible to help where needed (we have one position filled I believe)

Assistant Den Leaders – To encourage advancements in their dens and to help Charlotte with advancements and awards

There are other people already in the pack leadership who might want to fill some of these positions but I hesitate to assume they will want to.
